- title of the contribution that will be presented at ICIFMS-18;
- a resume or curriculum vitae.

Grant recipients will be notified by July 30, 2017.

Brazil adopts a policy of reciprocity regarding visas. This means that nationals of countries that require visas for Brazilian citizens will need a visa to travel to Brazil. According to the Brazilian law, Brazil needs to sign an agreement, on a reciprocal basis, to offer visa waiver to national of another country. Brazil has signed visa exemption agreements with more than 90 countries.
